Rev Caroline writes:

Today is the first week of 'Ordinary Time' and yet our lives are anything but ordinary. We lead rich, diverse and wonderful lives, full of experiences, both good and bad. Woven into this tapestry is our deep-rooted faith in God who we ask to journey alongside us through our ups and downs.

Our readings this week remind us that God's kingdom takes us way beyond the limits of our own individual stories and communities to be 'revolutionaries of tenderness' to others, even if they might not fit in, or they are people we would rather avoid. This week is Refugee Week and in Bishop Rose's message (see video below), she tells us that 'community' means expressing what we have in common, rather than finding all that divides. If Jesus calls those on the very edge of society, then we also, aided by the Holy Spirit, will be able to go beyond our own comfort zones, choosing to be a part of sharing God's love, and perhaps to be surprised when amazing things happen.

Ordination services for Deacons and Priests are taking place in Canterbury Cathedral on 28 June 2025 10.30. Anne Talbert from this Benefice is one of the Ordinands!

These services are a celebration of the work that has been undertaken by our ordinands, who have been training for between one and three years. The ordination training involves deepening their understanding of the Christian faith, and learning the skills needed to be a minister.
