

CHILLENDEN VILLAGE HALL NEEDS YOUR HELP

The Hall is owned and maintained by the church and is available for the whole community. The funding for the Hall comes mainly from the collections and donations made by the congregation of the church and any income from hirings. There is no support from central church finances nor from local councils. For many years the costs of running the Hall have significantly exceeded the income, typically in recent years by £800-£1,000, the main costs being insurance, utilities, and routine maintenance.

During and since the pandemic the church's finances have come under quite severe strain so we hope we have found a way for the village to come together and help fund the Hall's running costs, while having some fun. With your support there should be some money left over for us to make improvements as well.

We plan to set up a Small Society Lottery, the Chillenden Hall 100 Club, to raise funds for the operational costs and routine maintenance of the fabric and structure of the Hall. By joining the 100 Club you can help keep the Hall open and improve the fabric, as well as having a chance to win a cash prize every month. The Chillenden Hall 100 Club is open to all residents from the Parish of Chillenden with Knowlton and the surrounding area, their family and friends.

As a Small Society Lottery, you must be invited to join (members must be over 16). For each £5 entry, you will be allocated a number that goes into the draw.

Each month there will be a draw, with the prize fund being 50% of the total income for that month. This prize fund will be divided between 2 lucky winners. For example, if we have 100 members buying one number each the income for that month will be £500 and 50% will be used as the prize fund ie £250 split into two prizes:

- The 1st prize will be £200 (if 100 members) – 80% of prize fund
- The 2nd prize will be £50 (if 100 members) – 20% of prize fund

The more people buy an entry, the bigger the prize money, and the more funds there are! You may have (and are encouraged to do so) more than one entry per month.

CHILLENDEN HALL 100 CLUB: RULES

1. The object of the 100 Club is to raise funds for the operational running costs and routine maintenance of the fabric and structure of Chillenden Church Hall.
2. The 100 Club will be run under the supervision of the Rainbow Appeal Committee (registered Charity no. 1113056) of All Saints Chillenden PCC who will also administer the Club.
3. The 100 Club will be run as a Small Society Lottery and will be registered with Dover District Council.
4. The 100 Club is open to all Residents of the Parish of Chillenden with Knowlton and the surrounding area, their family and friends.
5. Members must be 16 or over.
6. Members must fill in an Application Form.
7. Entry to monthly draws will be by subscription of £5 per month per number, paid in advance, preferably by Standing Order based on a minimum period of twelve months (£60 per number per annum).
8. Members may have more than one number. The 100 Club shall not be limited to 100 members.
9. After the first draw (to be announced separately) additional new members will be entered for the draw in the calendar month that follows receipt of the first monthly payment. Responsibility for ensuring that the subscription has been paid rests with the individual member, not the Rainbow Appeal Committee.
10. The draw will be held monthly, with winning numbers generated randomly. The draw will generally be held at The Griffins Head Chillenden on the first Friday of each month.
11. Winners will be contacted personally by 100 Club administrators who will make all reasonable efforts to pay or post prizes to the winners within a week of each monthly draw.
12. Names of winners will be posted on the Village Noticeboard and on the Chillenden Village website (chillenden.org.uk) each month after the draw.
13. The regular monthly prize fund will be 50% of the total income for that month, with the remaining 50% of the total income allocated to the Rainbow Appeal Committee to fund operational running costs and routine maintenance of the fabric and structure of Chillenden Church Hall. Any surplus will go into a capital fund.
14. There will be two prizes each month:-
 - 1st prize = 80% of monthly prize fund
 - 2nd prize = 20% of monthly prize fund
15. Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
16. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
17. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the Rainbow Appeal Committee funds after 6 months.
18. The decision of the Rainbow Appeal Committee shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.
19. The Rainbow Appeal Committee shall have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
